Instructions to authors are published in the January issue each year; reprints are available from the editors and the Publications Department. The *Journal* is issued monthly, one volume per year. The nonmember subscription price is \$350 per year; single copies are \$30. The member subscription price is \$41 (foreign, \$63 [air drop shipping]) per year; single copies are \$8.00.
