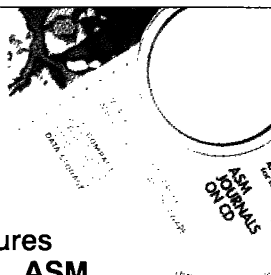

**D**esigned as a supplement for traditional medical microbiology texts, **CASES IN MEDICAL MICROBIOLOGY AND INFECTIOUS DISEASES** challenges students on their working knowledge of the various disciplines of medical microbiology, including bacteriology (34 cases), mycology (9 cases), parasitology (7 cases), and virology (16 cases). The authors have developed case histories of patients seen at a major university teaching hospital whose cases represent either typical infections caused by commonly encountered organisms or life-threatening or fatal infections caused by less frequently encountered organisms.

Cases are presented as "unknowns" and are accompanied by key questions, testing knowledge in four broad areas:

1. Organism characteristics and laboratory diagnosis
2. Pathogenesis and clinical characteristics
3. Epidemiology
4. Prevention and therapy

Detailed discussions are given on the pages following each case. In many of the cases, microscopic descriptions of the organisms are given so that the differential diagnosis can be narrowed. A list of organisms to be considered as possible etiologies of infection in the cases is found at the end of each section. Color slides illustrate organisms in detail. A glossary of clinical terms is included.
